

Student Disciplinary Procedure

Verbal Warning (Informal Stage) Chair: Course Tutor

- •To address minor misconduct or breaches of behaviour expectations in an informal and constructive manner
- •repetition of behaviour may trigger a 2 week action plan
- •If student is under 18 parents/carers must be informed of plan
- •if no improvement or behaviour is still below expectation at the end of the 2 week period this may trigger the next stage
- •Lecturer to record meeting and outcome on Microsoft form
- •Student Success Mentor to sign off action plan created by Course Tutor.
- •Invited to meeting-Course Tutor, Student Success Mentor and Student

Stage 1 Formal Discplinary

Chair:CourseTutor

- •To formally address repeated or more serious misconduct that was too serious for verbal warning or not resolved at the verbal warning stage.
- •A formal discplinary meeting is scheduled for the student with the Lecturer (chair), Student Sucess Mentor and student
- •For student under 18 Parent/Carer to be invited
- •Stage 1 outcome can be an action plan, change of support or timetable, restorative approach, first written warning or no furtheraction
- •There is no appeal for a stage one outcome
- •Lecturer to record meeting and outcome on Microsoft form
- •Student Success Mentor to write and monitor action plan.
- •Outcome letter to be prepared and sent to student by Chair (signed off by MD) within 5 working days of meeting
- •Invited to Meeting-Course Tutor, Studnet and Parent/Carers and Student Success Mentor

Stage 2 Formal Disciplnary

Chair: ALS Coordinator

•To escalate a repsonse when there is no improvement after a stage 1 intervention or if the misconduct is more serious.

- •A formal disciiplnary meeting is scheduled with Lecturer, Student Sucess Mentor, Send Coordinator (Chair) and Student
- •For Students under 18 Parent/Carer to be invited.
- •Stage 2 outcome could be downgrade to stage 1, no further action, action plan, first written warning or change of support/timetable.
- •There is no appeal for a stage two outcome
- •Send Coordinator to record meeting and outcome on Microsoft form
- •Student Success Mentor to write and monitor action plan.
- •Outcome letter to be prepared and sent to student by Chair (signed off by MD) within 5 working days of meeting
- •Invited to Meeting-ALS Coodinator, Course Tutor, Student, Parent/ Carers and Student Success Mentor

Stage 3 Formal Disciplinary Chair: Deputy Principal

- •To escalate a repsonse when there is no improvement after a stage 2 intervention or if the misconduct is more serious or constitutes gross misconduct as defined within policy
- •A formal disciiplnary meeting is scheduled with Lecturer, Deputy Principal (chair), Student Sucess Mentor, Send Coordinator and Student
- For Students under 18 Parent/Carer to be invited. appriate representative from KCC to be invited (Sen dept, SW, VSK)
- •Stage 3 outcome could be downgrade to stage 1/2, no further action, action plan or change of support/timetable, first or final written worning or could lead to exclusion.
- $\bullet \mbox{Stage}$ three outcome cannot be appealed except in the case of exclusion.
- •Deputy Principal to record meeting and outcome on microsoft form
- •Student Success Mentor to write and monitor action plan.
- Meeting to be recorded using Teams
- \bullet In the case of exclusion formal letter to be sent to KCC advisng them of decision.
- •Outcome letter to be prepared and sent to student by Chair (signed off by MD) within 5 working days of meeting
- •Invited ToMeeting-DeputyPrinicpal,CourseTutor,ALSCoordinator,Student,Parent/Carer,KCCSENDfundingandmonitoring Officer and Student Success Mentor

•Exclusion appeals to be made withing 14 calnedar days in wirting to the Managing Director.

- Exclusion appeal meeting to be scheduled and all parties who attended Stage 3 discplinary to attend.
- •Chair of stage three to present case for exclusion.
- •Meeting to be recorded using Teams
- •Decision to be made and communicated by the chair within 5 working days of the meeting
- •Chair to record outcome on Microsoft form.
- •The decision of the chiar is final and there is no further appeal.
- •If exclusion is overturned a final written warning is recorded on system and action plan put in place in line with stage 3 process.
- •Invited to Meeting-Principal, Deputy Principal, ALS Coordinator, Student, Parent/ Carer, KCC SEND funding and monitoring Officer and Student Success Mentor
